

Richmond Rod & Gun Club Bullseye Match

DATES: Sunday, December 24, 2023 AND Sunday, December 31, 2023

LOCATION: Richmond Rod & Gun Club (RR&GC) 200-yard range -- 3155 Goodrick Avenue, Richmond, CA 94801. To get to the 200-yard range, turn left immediately upon entering the front gate and drive to the end of the parking lot.

MATCH DIRECTOR: Matt Early / Ken Blaedel

ENTRY FEE: \$10 at registration on Sunday -- Entries are limited to the thirteen firing points available, so respond quickly to this announcement to reserve a spot on the line. (blaedel@pacbell.net)

COURSE OF FIRE: The course of fire will comprise a 900-point rimfire match and a 900-point centerfire match with registration beginning at 8:30am and first round down range at 9:00. Please note that this is a practice match, and you may shoot your rimfire pistol again in the second match if you wish.

.22 MATCH (9:00am)

Stage #1 – 20 shots slow fire, 2 strings of 10 rounds in 10 minutes

Stage #2 – 30-shot National Match Course: 10 slow fire, 10 timed fire, 10 rapid fire.

Stage #3 – 20 shots timed fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds in 20 seconds each

Stage #4 – 20 shots rapid fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds in 10 seconds each

Match #1 – 90 Shot .22 Aggregate

CF MATCH (following the .22 match with a 10-minute break)

Stage #5 – 20 shots slow fire, 2 strings of 10 rounds in 10 minutes

Stage #6 – 30-shot National Match Course: 10 slow fire, 10 timed fire, 10 rapid fire.

Stage #7 – 20 shots timed fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds in 20 seconds each

Stage #8 – 20 shots rapid fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds in 10 seconds each

Match #2 – 90 Shot Centerfire Aggregate

Also note that these are practice matches whose main purpose is to debug our match procedure in advance of receiving our turning targets. There will be no awards and no rules governing your pistol(s) other than those imposed by RR&GC.
