Sectionals are registered matches. All guidelines for registered matches will be followed. They are operated by match staff composed of local officials. All local challenges and protests are to be resolved on the match site according to procedures outlined in section 16 of the NRA International Pistol Rule book.

The **2023** National Indoor Championship is determined by scores fired in the local Sectional Tournaments, which are compiled at NRA Headquarters. For the purpose of the National Championship, the National Match Director may require that any or all fired targets from any sectional be sent to NRA Headquarters for rescoring under the provisions of Rule 16.

NOTICE: All fired targets must be retained until the challenge period for the National Indoor Championship has ended, two weeks after the bulletin is mailed to all competitors.

National Indoor Championships Match Officials:

RULES: Current NRA International and Conventional Pistol Rules will govern.

SCORES CARDS: Special Individual score cards will be used and must be signed by the competitor to be considered for National ranking. All information must be filled in or scores will not be scored.

DISTANCE: 50 Feet

PISTOL: .22 Caliber

TARGETS Standard Pistol NRA Official 50 feet, B-33

Precision Pistol NRA Official 50 feet, B-2 & B-3

Eligibility: A competitor (individual or team) may enter any Open NRA Sectional Indoor Championship but may fire in only ONE of this type Sectional tournament in 2023. Competitors may enter other types of Sectionals if eligibility limitations permit.

NOTE: As of July 1, 2008, to compete in NRA Registered tournaments, NRA membership is encourage, but not required.

All teams will consist of three (4) for conventional and (3) for Standard firing members representing a club affiliated with NRA (rule 2.11 (A), (B), Regular service unit, National Guard or Reserves (Rule 2.13) or a State Association (Rule 2.12). Teams composed of competitors not all in the same category are mixed teams. Mixed teams in Sectionals may fire for open awards only. Scores for mixed teams will not be use for National ranking or awards. A foreign competitor is eligible to participate in the Sectional(s) (and National level Rule 2.1.1), only U.S. citizens may win the First, Second and Third place National Individual and Team Championship awards.

CATEGORIES: A grand senior, senior, woman, special award will be presented to the HIGH GRAND SENIOR, HIGH SENIOR, HIGH WOMAN, in the National Individual Championship only.

CLASSIFICATION: Each competitor will be classified according to the NRA International Classification and NRA Precision Classification. System and must be prepared to exhibit a current Classification Card or Score Record Book upon registration. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class (Rule 19.6). Teams will be classified according to Rule 19.12.

SOUVENIR AWARDS: NRA has provided the sponsors with participation pins to be given to each competitor.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (See Rule 16.1 for correct procedure).

TIES: Ties will be broken according to NRA International Pistol Rules, Rule 15.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Entries in the Individual match will be made by submitting the enclosed Registration and Entry Card accompanied by check or money order to the local match sponsor. Be sure to state date and time you wish to fire, current, correct International classification and NRA Membership number, if applicable.

TEAM ENTRIES: Team members must be designated before the individual matches commence. The individual match scores will be used for the team scores total. The team match is not a fired match.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Advance individual match entries must be received no later than **Monday, March 5, 2018**, preceding the opening date of the tournament. Team match entries must be made any time prior to the start of any team member's firing in the individual match.

ENTRIES LIMITED: Entries are limited to **40** competitors, which is the range capacity for the time allotted. Persons making entry within the time limit that cannot be accepted will be notified and their fees will be returned.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted up to the range capacity provided such entries would not require extra relays.

FEES: **NRA INDIVIDUAL SECTIONAL REGISTRATION FEE:** \$8.00 per competitor per match includes entry of the individual in the 2023 NRA National Open Individual Indoor International Standard Pistol Championships and National Open Individual Indoor Precision Pistol Championship.

NRA TEAM SECTIONAL REGISTRATION FEE: \$5.00 per team per match includes entry of the team in the 2023 NRA National Open Team Indoor Conventional Pistol Championship and International Pistol Championship.

SECTIONAL MATCH ENTRY FEES:

Individual Matches	\$25.00 per competitor (includes NRA fee \$8)
	\$35.00 for both Precision and Standard
Team Matches	\$5.00 per team (NRA fee)

SQUADDING: Competitors will be squadded. Teams are not required to be squadded together to fire as a unit.
