RULES: Current NRA/CMP rules for approved tournaments will govern.

ENTRIES LIMITED: Entries will be limited to one relay of 20 competitors.
Priority will be given to those firing all 2 matches
NRA membership is not required.

FEES: An entry fee of \$25.00 for none members
Match is open to everyone.

TIME: 9:00 AM. Only 1 relay of 20 shooters can be accommodated due to time and space.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Failure of a competitor to obtain his squadding tickets or to present himself at the proper firing point when relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

SCORING: Scoring will be by competitors in teams of two after each stage.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. Competitors without a valid classification card or Score Record Book will compete in the master class.

Classes: Separate class awards will be given.

1. If a class has 3 or less competitors, that class will be combined with the next higher class
2. No class will be combined into the high master class.
3. If any class, including the high master class consists of less than five competitors, awards will be given only for the aggregate Matches.
4. No class will be moved up more than one class.
