**Classification:** Known capability.

**Rules:** All current NRA Conventional and USA Shooting International rules shall govern the administration of these tournaments.

**Range Capacity:** 1 relay, 17 competitors.

### **COURSES OF FIRE**

#### Precision Pistol Matches

Open 90 shots. B6 (50 yard slow fire) and B8 (25 yard timed and rapid fire) targets

Match 1, Slow fire, two strings of 10 shots in 10 minutes

Match 2, National Match Course, 10 shots each slow, timed and rapid fire

Match 3, Timed fire, four strings of 5 shots in 20 seconds

Match 4, Rapid fire, four strings of 5 shots in 10 seconds

Match 5, Aggregate

#### International Air Pistol

Iron Sights, 60 shots; Air Pistol B40 targets (10 meters).

Total time for 60 shots including unlimited sighters is 1 hour 45 minutes. Five shots per Target.

### COURSES OF FIRE

#### International Free Pistol

Iron Sights, 60 shots. B 19 targets (50 yards). Total time for 60 shots including unlimited sighters is 2 hours. Twenty shots per bull. Fired as a 17 minute sighters period, then three series of 20 shots in 34 minutes. All sighters shots are fired before the first record shot.

#### Standard Pistol

Iron Sights, 60 shots. B6 (50 yard slow fire) and B8 (25 yard timed and rapid fire) targets  
Match 1, Slow fire, four strings of 5 shots in 150 seconds  
Match 2, Timed fire, four strings of 5 shots in 20 seconds  
Match 3, Rapid fire, four strings of 5 shots in 10 seconds  
Match 4, Aggregate

#### Falling Plates

The Falling Plates Rack consists of Six Metal Plates, approximately 8 inches in diameter. The Game requires every participant to shoot as many plates as possible in a specific time frame, which depends on the distance and firearm used, as follows:

Falling Plates – Pistol is shot from 10, 15, 20, 25 and 30 yards and the times are 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 seconds respectively.

Falling Plates – Rifle is shot from 30, 35, 40, 45 and 50 yards and the times are 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 seconds respectively.

Only .22 Rimfire (Long Rifle, Long or Short) only are allowed.

No other caliber or any Magnums are permitted.

Courses of Fire are the same for both, Pistol and Rifle:

the competitor shall load only 6 (six) rounds, and will shoot within the mentioned time slots.

A timer is used to establish the shooting periods. Every participant will be called to the shooting lane, at which said participant will arrive with two magazines or speed loaders, with no more than 6 (six) rounds on each, and will load the firearm when directed to do so by the Match Director. Two strings of 6 (six) shots will take place. There are no alibis whatsoever.

Only fallen plates will count as 1 (one) point each, towards the maximum possible of 60 points.

### FALLING PLATES LEAGUE SHOOT

Falling Plates Matches on 2026 will have the interesting possibility of participating in the League Shoot.

This will be for both Pistol and Rifle Falling Plates Matches, separately.

Therefore there will be

a League Shoot for Falling Plates - Pistol and a League Shoot for Falling Plates - Rifle Matches.

The Shooter with the highest aggregate of the best 5 scores of the year will be named as the  
Winner of the League Shoot.

There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd possible positions with monetary prizes of \$100.00 \$50.00 and \$25.00  
respectively plus Trophies.

Competitors must participate in  
*at least 5 (five) Matches*

to have a chance to become a Winner, paying an additional \$10.00 on top of the regular Fees per Match.

### COURSES OF FIRE

#### Coyote Point Benchrest Match Course of Fire

- 1) 100 yards is the distance from the firing line to targets, variable to as short as 95 yards if a match is held during rain.
- 2) The match target is the NRA A27 "50 Yard Smallbore Prone Target" with one sighting bull and four scoring bulls.
- 3) Ten shots are allowed on each scoring bull.
- 4) Unlimited shots are allowed on the sighter bull.
- 5) After the match officially starts, 40 scoring shots (plus unlimited sighters) must be fired in a maximum of 40 minutes. Except for unforeseen circumstances, there will be no intermission or interruption. Any officially-called interruption time will be added to the 40 normal minutes. Late competitor arrivals are not considered "unforeseen circumstances" for the purpose of match interruption.
- 6) The total possible score is 400 points.
- 7) .22 rimfire (no magnums) only.
- 8) No restriction on firearm weight, action or sophistication.
- 9) No restriction on firearm support (benchrest) weight or sophistication.
- 10) Unofficial sighting-in on non-A27 targets starts at 0830.
- 11) The match briefing by the Match Director starts at 0900.
- 12) Official sighting-in on the A27 targets starts at 0915.
- 13) The match starts at 1000.
- 14) The match fee is \$5 for Coyote Point R&P Club members and \$25 for non members. Please bring exact amounts.
- 15) After the match, competitors will retrieve their targets, write their first and last names on them and give them to the Match Director.
- 16) Standard NRA scoring rules apply. A shot which is mostly located in a lower scoring ring but which touches a higher scoring ring will be assigned the higher number.
- 17) The Match Director will assign a score to each target, arrange all names/scores onto a results form and submit it to the Club's centralized reporting authority for approval and publication.

#### Coyote Point Any Rifle Match

- 1) The distance from the firing line to the targets is 50 yards.
- 2) Any non-artificially supported position may be used. Prone is recommended.
- 3) Only .22 rimfire (no magnums) ammunition may be used.
- 4) NRA Any Rifle rules apply: There are no restrictions on gun or trigger weight, sling, jacket, pants and gloves. The only restriction will be that NO artificial support such as bipods and sandbags may be used.
- 5) The NRA A27 "50 Yard Smallbore Prone Target" with one sighter bull and four scoring bulls will be used.
- 6) During the match unlimited sighters may be taken on the sighter bull.
- 7) During the match 10 shots will be taken on each of the four scoring bulls.
- 8) The 40 shot match (plus any in-match sighters) must be completed within 40 minutes. Except for unforeseen circumstances, there will be no intermission or interruption. Any officially-called interruption time will be added to the 40 normal minutes. Late competitor arrivals are not considered "unforeseen circumstances" for the purpose of match interruption.
- 9) Unofficial sighting-in on non-A27 targets starts at 0830.
- 10) The match briefing by the Match Director starts at 0900.
- 11) Official sighting-in on the A27 target starts at 0915.
- 12) The match starts at 0930.
- 13) There are two categories, **scoped** and **iron sight**. Scoped entries will be scored separately from iron sight entries, and a winner will be declared for each category.
- 14) The total possible score is 400 points.
- 15) The match fee is \$5 for Coyote Point R&P Club members and \$25 for non-members. Please try to bring the exact amounts.
- 16) After the match, competitors will retrieve their targets, write their first and last names on them and give them to the Match Director.
- 17) Standard NRA scoring rules apply. A shot which is mostly located in a lower scoring ring but which touches a higher scoring ring will be assigned the higher number.
- 18) The Match Director will assign a score to each target, arrange all names/scores on a results form and submit it to the Club's centralized reporting authority for approval and publication.
