CMP MATCH PISTOL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP 2700, CMP MATCH PISTOL SHORT COURSE 2700,
SERVICE PISTOL, SERVICE REVOLVER AND .22 RIMFIRE PISTOL MATCHES

June 21 – June 23, 2024

ELIGIBILITY This Tournament is open to all shooters and new shooters are welcomed. CMP applications will be available at registration, though CMP membership is not required for participation. NOTE: If your 18th birthday occurs after the tournament date you MUST contact Michael Gasser at the address below for a waiver form which must be signed by a parent and turned in at registration.

ENTRIES Entries for the Tournament will be limited to the first 48 competitors (TWO Relays of 24 shooters) and may be accepted up until the first shot of the Centerfire Match. In the case of more than 48 applicants, priority will be given to pre-paid entries in order of receipt, and to competitors shooting the full 2700. There will be TWO Relays of Friday's Short Course 2700, with additional priority being given to shooters also participating in the State Championship. ** The Service Pistol, Service Revolver and .22 Rimfire Pistol Match are NOT EIC matches, scores will NOT be reported to the CMP, and participation will NOT count against your EIC match limit (5) for the year. The Service Pistol EIC, Service Revolver EIC and .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Matches are for possible Leg Points, the scores will be reported to the CMP and WILL count against your EIC match limit for the year. For each match type (.22 Rimfire, Service Pistol or Service Revolver), shooters may shoot in either EIC or the non-EIC version, but not both.*

.22 ONLY AGGREGATE Competitors may elect to fire only their .22 handgun through the entire Regional 2700, subject to CMP Pistol Rules. These competitors will compete for class prizes only during the .22 Match portion of the Regional 2700. Such competitors will not be eligible to win the Championship. Such competitors will likely be squadded next to other competitors firing centerfire calibers during the Centerfire and .45 matches.

.22 RIMFIRE PISTOL MATCHES There will be two matches – one an EIC match and one a non-EIC match. Both matches will be subject to all CMP rules. EIC shooters will shoot separately from non-EIC shooters. No infiltration by shooters firing Service Pistol. Course of Fire – National Match Course.

SERVICE PISTOL MATCHES There will be two matches – one an EIC match and one a non-EIC match. Both matches will be subject to all CMP rules. EIC shooters will shoot separately from non-EIC shooters. Course of Fire – National Match Course.

SERVICE REVOLVER MATCHES There will be two matches – one an EIC match and one a non-EIC match. Both matches will be subject to all CMP rules. EIC shooters will shoot separately from non-EIC shooters. Course of Fire – President's Course.

THE CENTER SHOOTOUT All shooters in the State Championship 2700 are automatically entered, with shooters being eliminated until the Shootout Champion is chosen. For purposes of this match, the shooter's Classification will be the HIGHER of their CMP Match Pistol Class and their NRA Precision Pistol Class.

Target Scoring Criteria:

High Masters/Masters: Shots in the 10 and X-rings count one point, others count as 0 points

Experts: Shots in the 9, 10 and X-rings count as one point, others count as 0 points

Marksmen/Sharpshooters: Shots in the 8, 9, 10 and X-rings count as one point, others count as 0 points

Course of Fire

- Qualification** All shooters firing a 10-point target (as described above) on the 3rd TIMED-FIRE STAGE of the .22 900 will qualify.
- Rounds 1, 2** For each round, each survivor will shoot a Timed-Fire Target (10 shots) with their .22 Pistol. After each Round, shooters scoring less than 10 points are eliminated.**
- Rounds 3,4** Same as Rounds 1,2, except survivors shoot a Rapid-Fire Target.
- Rounds 5+** Same as Round 3,4, except all survivors will be promoted to the next higher group every 2 Rounds.

*- Ties broken by X-count, then 10-count, etc. Ties that cannot be broken may result in more than 10 qualifiers.
**-Should all competitors be eliminated in a Round, the winner will be the highest scoring target, with ties being broken by X-count, then 10-count, etc. A tie that cannot be broken will result in co-champions.

AWARDS

CMP Match Pistol State Championship

Match Winner - Trophy, Cash Prize of \$250

High SC Resident – Trophy, Cash Prize of \$250

2nd Place – Cash Prize of \$150

3rd Place – Cash Prize of \$100

Class Awards – Trophies, Cash Awards based on the number of entrants per class.

The CMP Match Pistol Short Course 2700 (Friday)

No Awards or Prizes, though scores will be reported to the CMP.

EIC Matches: EIC points earned, CMP pins

10-Ring Shootout: The Cash Prize will consist of \$1 for each scoring shot, beginning with Round 1, with a minimum payout of \$100 being guaranteed.

PRIZE POOLS The Service Pistol Combined Match (EIC and non-EIC), the Service Revolver Combined Match (EIC and non-EIC), and the .22 Rimfire Combined Match (EIC and non-EIC), will each have their own Prize Pool. Each Match entrant will receive one Prize Pool Drawing ticket for that event. Tickets for the Cash-For-Cleans drawings will be distributed to any shooter cleaning a Short Line (1 ticket) or Long Line (5 tickets) target. All participants in the 2700 Championship will receive 1 Cash-For-Cleans ticket at the beginning of the match. On Sunday, at the conclusion of all shooting events, the Prize Pools will be constructed and resolved as below.

Service Pistol, Service Revolver and .22 Rimfire Matches: For each Combined Match, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers will be awarded 5, 3 and 1 additional Prize Pool Drawing tickets, respectively. Each Prize Pool will consist of \$5 per entrant in that Combined Match, with the winner determined by random drawing. Both EIC and non-EIC shooters will participate in the pools.

Cash-For-Cleans: The Prize Pool and number of drawings will be determined by participation.

BOUNTIES Bounties are rewards for shooting with a specified precision at the Long Line. The Bounty will be collected by the FIRST shooter per Relay meeting the requirements. Each Bounty is \$25 and maybe a pie but Sally has not committed to filling Karen's shoes to that extent just yet.

<u>Class</u>	<u>Precision Requirement</u>
Marksman	All shots score 8 or higher (8s & Up) minimum score of 80
Sharpshooter	All shots score 8 or higher (8s & Up) minimum score of 85
Expert	All shots score 9 or higher (9s & Up) minimum score of 90
Master	All shots score 10 or higher (10s & Up) minimum score of 95
High Master	All shots score 10 or higher (10s & Up) minimum score of 100

CLASSIFICATION CMP Match Pistol classifications will be used. In the case that a shooter does not have a CMP Match Pistol Classification, Classification will be assigned using the following precedence: NRA Precision Pistol > CMP Pistol > CMP Rimfire Pistol. Shooters still unclassified will compete in Master Class.

CATEGORIES: Categories will be recognized in accordance with CMP Rules. Women may compete in the Women Category. The Service Category is open to all Service Personnel, and split into Active Duty and National Guard/Reserve. Shooters not shooting in the Service Category may shoot in the Civilian Category, further split into the Junior (Born June 23, 2003 or later), Senior (Born June 21 1964 or earlier), Grand Senior (born June 21, 1954 or earlier) and Law Enforcement sub-categories. Categories/Sub-categories claimed must be stated by the shooter on their registration form.

COMBINATION OF CLASSIFICATIONS: For purposes of Cash Awards, if less than FIVE competitors are entered in a class, that class will be combined with the next highest class until award groups of five or more are created. For example, if there are less than THREE competitors remaining in the High Master Class, after removing the Top 3 Overall Shooters, there will no cash award to the winner of the High Master Class.

SQUADDING: Squadding will be finalized before June 20, 2024, with every effort being made to accommodate competitor's preferences. Should there be 24 or fewer entrants for the Short Course on Friday, the relays will be combined.

LUNCH: Lunch will be provided to all competitors on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

SHOOTER DINNER: All shooters and their families are invited to the Shooter Dinner on Saturday night, after the conclusion of shooting. All food, beverages and entertainment are provided at no charge. The Dinner is held at the MCGC Pavilion. Details will be released as they become available.

OTHER: Current CMP Pistol Rules will apply. Scoring will be done in the target frames by the competitors after each designated course of fire. The Challenge Fee is \$3.00. All scorers may use scoring overlays. Plugs will be used by tournament officials only.

SHOOTER STICKERS Shooters who provide all the information requested will have their information entered on their scorecards for them. We will create packets for you. Missing information will result in unnecessary hand cramps.
